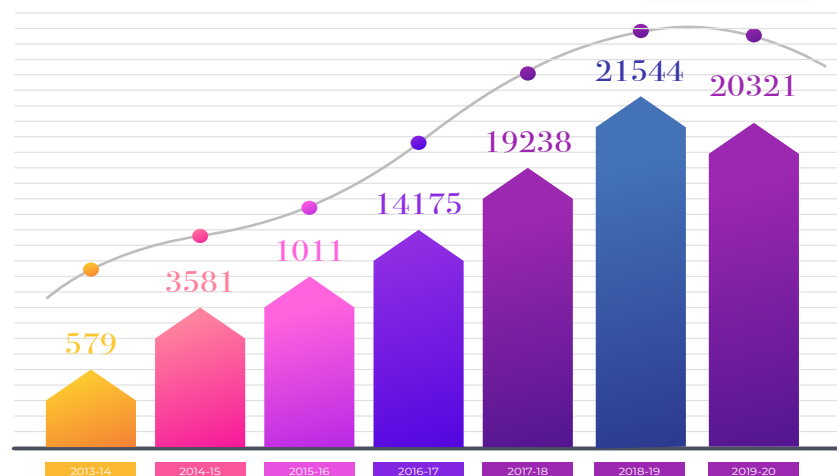
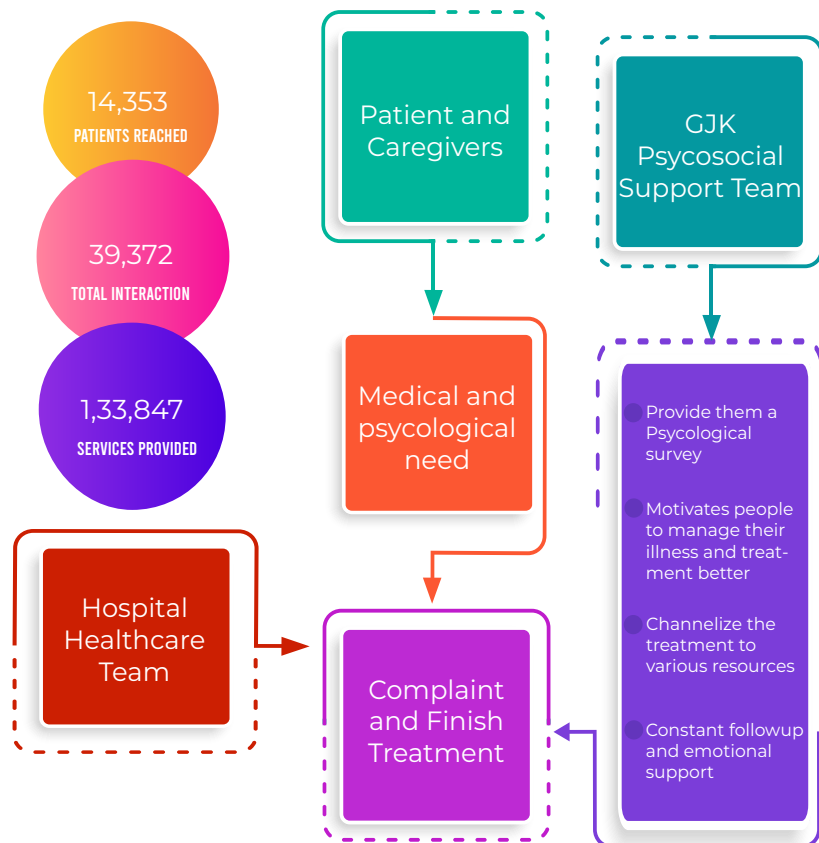

(FISCAL YEAR WISE)**

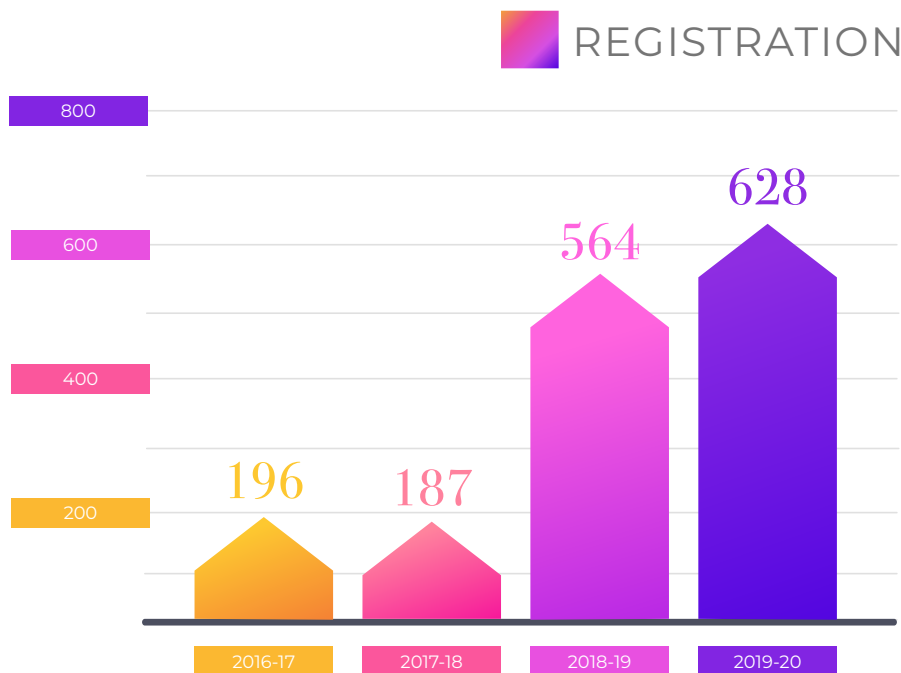
COMMUNITY HEALTH EMPOWERMENT

Better Health of Pregnant Women

The program aims to educate pregnant women from low socio-economic backgrounds about health care during pregnancy and thus encouraging health-seeking behaviour in them for safe deliveries.

Special efforts are made by our coordinators to encourage women to register themselves in the Hospital within their first trimester.

CANCER PREVENTION & EARLY DETECTION PROGRAM

Encourage Health Seeking Behaviour in Women

The program aims to spread cancer awareness and educate women from underserved areas importance of early detection of most common cancers in women like Breast Cancer, Cervical Cancer and Oral Cancer. The awareness talks not only help women gain more knowledge about the common cancers in women but also motivate and empower them to make informed choices about their health.

The talks are followed by 'Cancer Detection Camp' where registered women undergo specific tests to detect the common cancers in women.
